How does the \$4 generic affect my prescription drug program?

Many national chain pharmacies now offer a 30-day supply of generic prescriptions for \$4. You can find a list of these drugs at the pharmacies that offer the \$4 generic program. The list contains hundreds of generic drugs. Are you confused how this works with your City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card? Following are answers to your questions:

Q. Why would I use my City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card to buy a \$4 generic when my City of Bryan generic copay is \$7 for a 30-day supply?

A. When you use your City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card to purchase a \$4 generic you will always pay the lowest cost—in this case \$4 and not \$7.

Q. Can I get the \$4 generic without using my City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card?

A. Yes; however, it is not recommended. By using your City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card, important drug utilization information is processed to make sure you are not taking a medication that interferes with the new medication.

Q. What will be my cost for a 90-day generic prescription at retail?

A. Many national chain pharmacies now offer a 90-day supply for \$10. You will always pay the lowest cost—in this case \$10 and not \$15. You still need to present your City of Bryan Prescription Drug Card; and you will always pay the lowest cost.
